NWCA SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION PRESS RELEASE

The Navy Wives Clubs of America give 30 scholarships annually in amounts from \$1,000 to \$1,500. The grants are presented with the knowledge that no repayment is expected from the recipient.

Those eligible for the grants are the natural born, legally adopted or stepson or daughter of an **ENLISTED** member of the Navy, Marine Corps or Coast Guard on active duty, retired with pay or the son/daughter of a deceased member of these categories. The applicant must have a valid Dependent ID card (United States Uniformed Services Identification & Privilege Card). The applicant must show basis of need for financial assistance, have a scholastic standing of at least a 2.5 grade point average (GPA) and be a graduate of an accredited High School or its equivalent or will qualify for graduation prior to beginning eligibility for assistance. The applicant should be physically capable of completing the course undertaken and be of good character. The grants are for tuition, room and board, fees, and books.

The deadline for Scholarship applications is May 30th. Please send a self-addressed stamped envelope when requesting an application. Scholarship applications can be obtained from the following address:

In my final letter to you as Junior Past Pin Chairman, I want to bring you up to date on the latest in this chairmanship. Ten (10) more dies were given to us by SWJ. Susan Hutchinson was kind enough to pick them up and bring them to National Convention for us.

They were rusty, but Larry was able to shine them up and I have sent them on to HR our new pin company. Dies/trim tools sent were:

Numeral's #46, #96, #150, #167, #201 and #241,
Alpha letters ER, NWR, and MAL. Whidbey
Island #150's Special Island die was also sent.

There was also a die of our Membership pin design with a wreath surrounding it. I sent this to HR to evaluate to see if we could use this in some way, perhaps as a charm or necklace. This information will come soon and our new

National Pin Chairman, TerriLee Young, will keep us informed.

The National Convention delegation voted to spend the money for club Officer Guard and National Chairman Pin. This is a total of 10 dies with trim tools. Because we're having so many made at the same time, HR is giving us a wonderful price break.

More good news. Our Membership pin can be made into a dangle at no extra cost. They can also provide an 18" chain, SS \$43.00 or GF \$55.00. Our Membership pin can also be made into pierced earrings, post or wire, SS \$50.00, GF \$62.00. Our NWCA Bar pin can be made into a necklace (chain at both ends) SS \$40.00, GF \$48.50. Our other pins and guards can be

made into a dangle for an additional fee of \$2.00 each if design will accommodate. If you'd like a pin or guard placed on a round disk, they can do this SS \$28.00, GF \$34.00 (disk cost only. I have asked to see samples of the chains and disks available to us.

HR can also provide a tri-fold brochure for us, showing all NWCA jewelry available and the pricing. I think this is something we should work on for next year. Pricing will depend on just what we want. I **STRONGLY URGE** all clubs that have not had their dies pulled from permanent storage to do so as soon as possible. We want our brochure to be as complete as possible because this is something that will probably be costly and needs to last a few years. Remember our OC Tanner brochure? This is what we have in mind.

This past year was great, enjoyed it so much. My best wishes to TerriLee our new Pin Chairman. I'm here to help her in any way.
