To be eligible, an applicant must be a dependent son/daughter (natural, legally adopted or stepchild) of an active duty, retired with pay or deceased ENLISTED member of the US Navy, Marine Corps, or Coast Guard service.

The applicant must have a valid Dependent ID card. The applicant must show a basis of need for financial assistance, have at least a 2.5 GPA & be a graduate of an accredited High School. Upper class students are welcomed to apply.

Applicants should be of good character. All grants are for tuition, room and board, fees and books.

The deadline for Scholarship applications is: **Postmarked by March 31st.**
